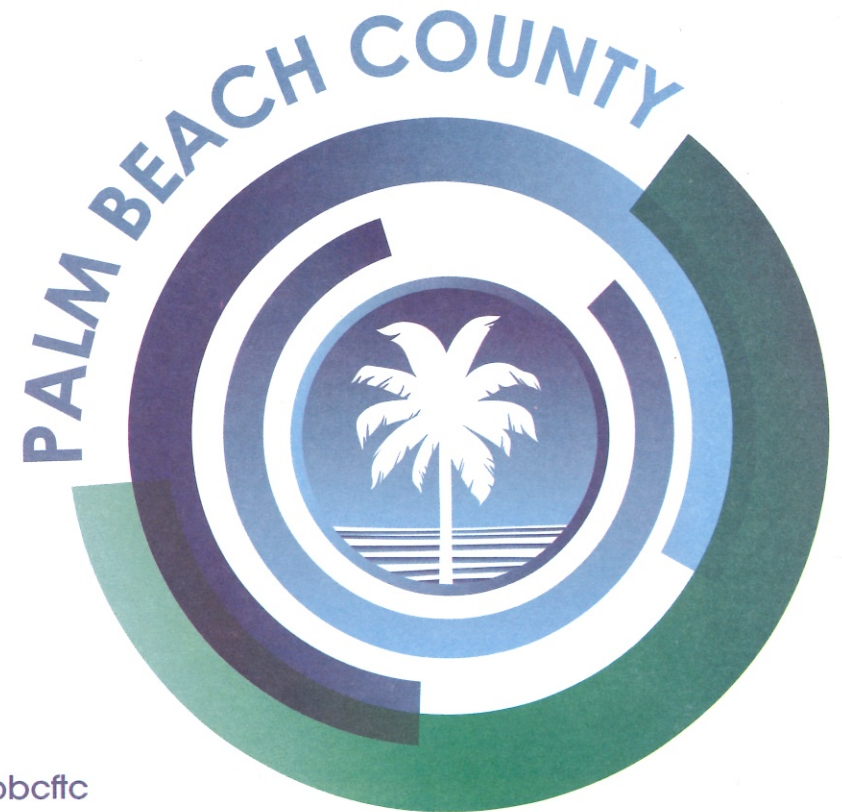

1. Production of the 2022 Student Showcase of Films Competition and Awards Ceremony (SSOF):

Status: COMPLETED

The 27th annual Palm Beaches Student Showcase of Films was held on May 6, 2022 at the Maltz Jupiter Theatre in Jupiter, Florida. A full report was previously provided in the ~~2nd~~ ^{3rd} Quarterly Report (~~April~~ ^{July} 14, 2022).

Dates have been secured for the 2023 SSOF – April 19th and April 20th for load-in/rehearsal and April 21st for the live awards show. The Maltz Jupiter Theatre and its Producing Artistic Director/Chief Executive Andrew Kato have committed to host the 2023 Student Showcase of Films.

Additionally, the following sponsors have committed to the 2023 SSOF: Film Florida (\$500 for the Sara Fuller Scholarship), Keep Palm Beach County Beautiful (\$1,000 for the Environmental PSA Award), Michael Chasin (\$500 for The Fred and Nellie Chasin Screenwriting Scholarship) and Suzanne Niedland (\$1,000 for the Suzanne Niedland Documentary Scholarship) and new to the program, the Mel Maron Scholarship. \$1,676.17 was raised to use over the next several years.

All financials have been wrapped up. The program stayed within the \$75,000 budget.

2. Award \$15,000 in scholarships to the Student Showcase of Films winning student filmmakers and/or film programs:

Status: COMPLETED

18 students/schools were awarded a total of \$21,000. A total of \$15,000 funded by the Department of Housing & Economic Sustainability. The remaining funded by sponsors: Film Florida contributed a \$1,000 scholarship for the Sara Fuller Scholarship Award, Michael Chasin contributed \$500 for the Fred and Nellie Chasin Screenwriting Scholarship Award, Rolando Barrero contributed \$500 for the Poster Design Award, Keep Palm Beach County Beautiful, Inc. contributed \$1,000 for the Environmental PSA Award and Suzanne Niedland contributed \$1,000 for the Suzanne Niedland Documentary Scholarship, and \$2,000 was contributed to the Burt Reynolds Scholarship Award.

3. Half Hour TV Show, *The Student Showcase of Films Special Edition*:

Status: COMPLETED

The FTC secured an estimated total of **\$109,541.60** in grant matching, cash, Burt Reynolds & Mel Maron cash Scholarship and in-kind contributions in this quarter.
